



Burnisher Troubleshooting

• Pad is not touching the floor.

- 1. Make sure the pad lever is up. *Tap the foot pedal on the back of the machine to lower the pad.*
- 2. If the above does not correct the problem, a tech would be needed.

• Burnisher is making a loud noise and vibrating.

- 1. Check that the pad is CENTERED on the pad driver.
- 2. Check the condition of the pad. *Worn or dirty pads should be replaced as needed.*
- 3. If none of the above corrects the problem, a tech would be needed.

• Burnisher is creating a lot of dust.

- 1. Check the filter bags and replace as needed.
- 2. Check the condition of the pad. Worn or dirty pads should be replaced as needed.

• Pad is not spinning.

- 1. Make sure the pad is DOWN. *Tap the foot pedal on the back of the machine to lower the pad.*
- 2. Is the operator turning the grips in order to activate the machine?
- 3. If none of the above corrects the problem, a tech would be needed.

• Burnisher is leaving swirl marks.

1. Pad is dirty, check and replace. *Make sure pad is natural fiber and not red.*

• Reduced run time.

- 1. Pad pressure is too high. Check the pressure meter and adjust the pad pressure lever so the pressure meter stays in the green area
- 2. Batteries need to be charged, make sure they have water as well
